**ENTRIES:** To be received by the Secretary of the meeting, by post, before **Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> June** together with the entry fee of £20.00 and 2 stamped addressed envelopes. The maximum number of entries will be 150. **Entries in reverse order of receipt. i.e early entry = late number.**

Category 1 motorcycles as per NSC. Group A1 solos,

**START:** The start will be at Haslin Farm, past High Edge Raceway, Near Buxton. Signs off the A53 Buxton to Leek Road. OS map reference 119/SK 066 693. The first rider will start at **9 01 am** the rest in riding number order. **The course will include the use of public roads.** 1 event RTA Insurance cover will be available at the start.

NB. The Public Highway is used and it is the riders responsibility to ensure that both his/her machine and him/herself are fully legal for the purpose.

**COURSE:** 1 lap of approximately 30 miles and approximately 40 sections

**MARKING:** Marking will be according to TSR 22A

### CLASSES:

There are two classes: - National and Clubmen class. National Class do the harder route. Clubman Class do the easier route.

Premier: Dave Rowland Trophy.  
Runner Up: Norman Eyre Trophy.  
Best over 275cc Mick Wilkinson Trophy.  
Best 225cc to 275cc John Shirt Trophy.  
First Class Awards to best 10% of entries in the National Class

### The Edgar Trophy:

This is the second of 4 road trials run by Manchester 17 this year: Fisher Trophy 11<sup>th</sup> January, Dave Rowland 5<sup>th</sup> July, Hipwell Trial for the Hartle Trophy 20<sup>th</sup> September and Northern Experts 10<sup>th</sup> November. Best performance on a solo machine over the 4 events will win The 'Edgar Trophy' tenable for 1 year, a cash prize of £300 and a replica to keep. Points are awarded at each round using the same system as the British Trials Championship.
