BRILLIANT BANTAM RIDE

Dave's second place on the experimental model, developed by competition manager Brian Martin, was one of the highlights of this year's Highland classic.

And it was backed up by the fact that all four Bantams in the trial, ridden by Rowland, Mick Bowers, Alan Morewood and Dave Langston, not only finished but gained special first-class awards.
