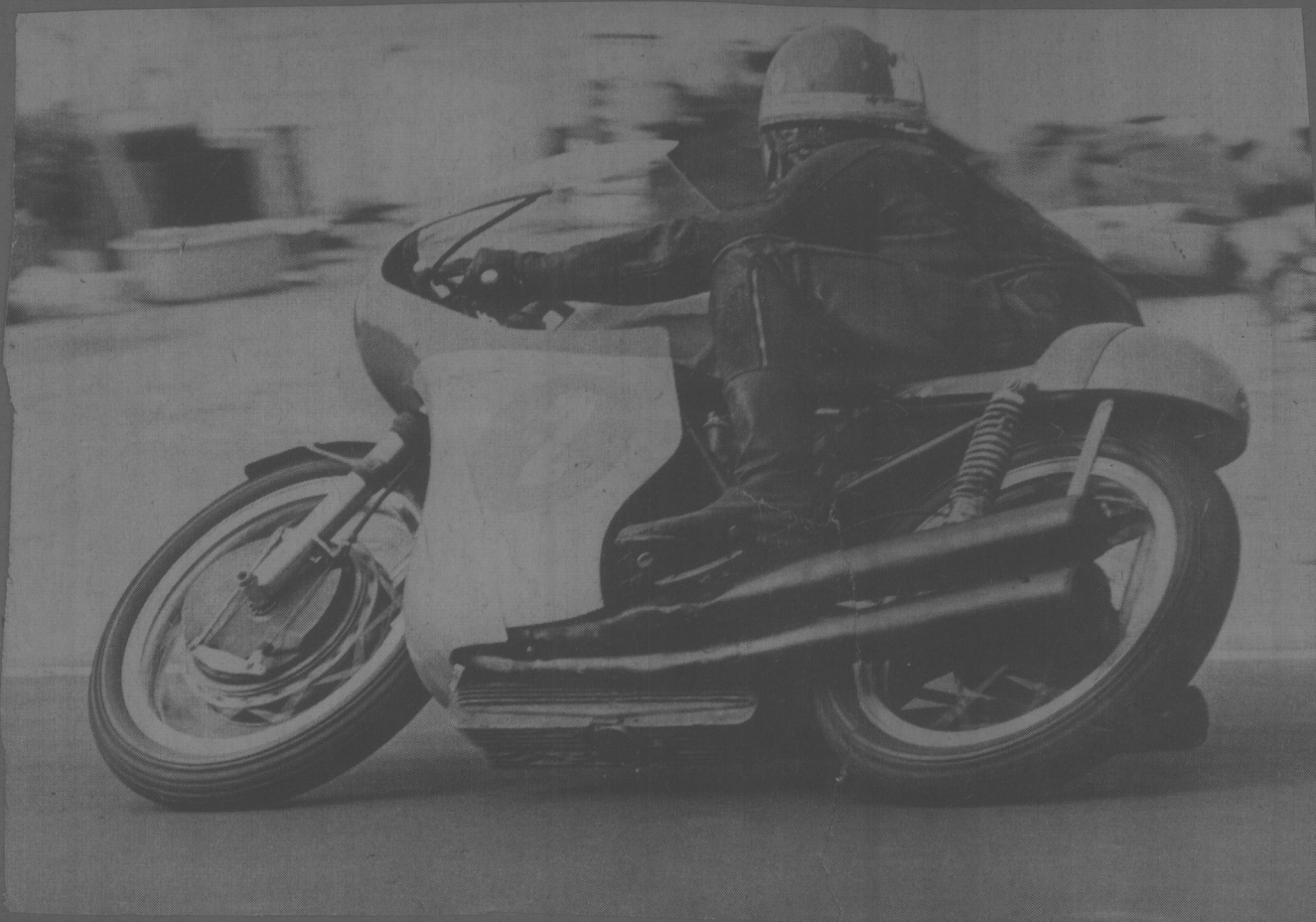
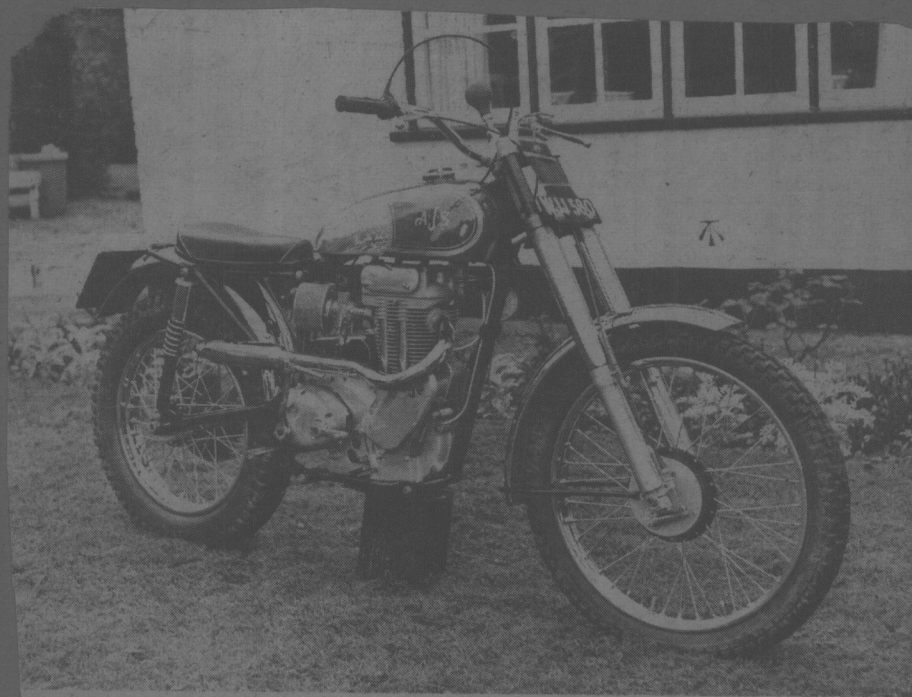
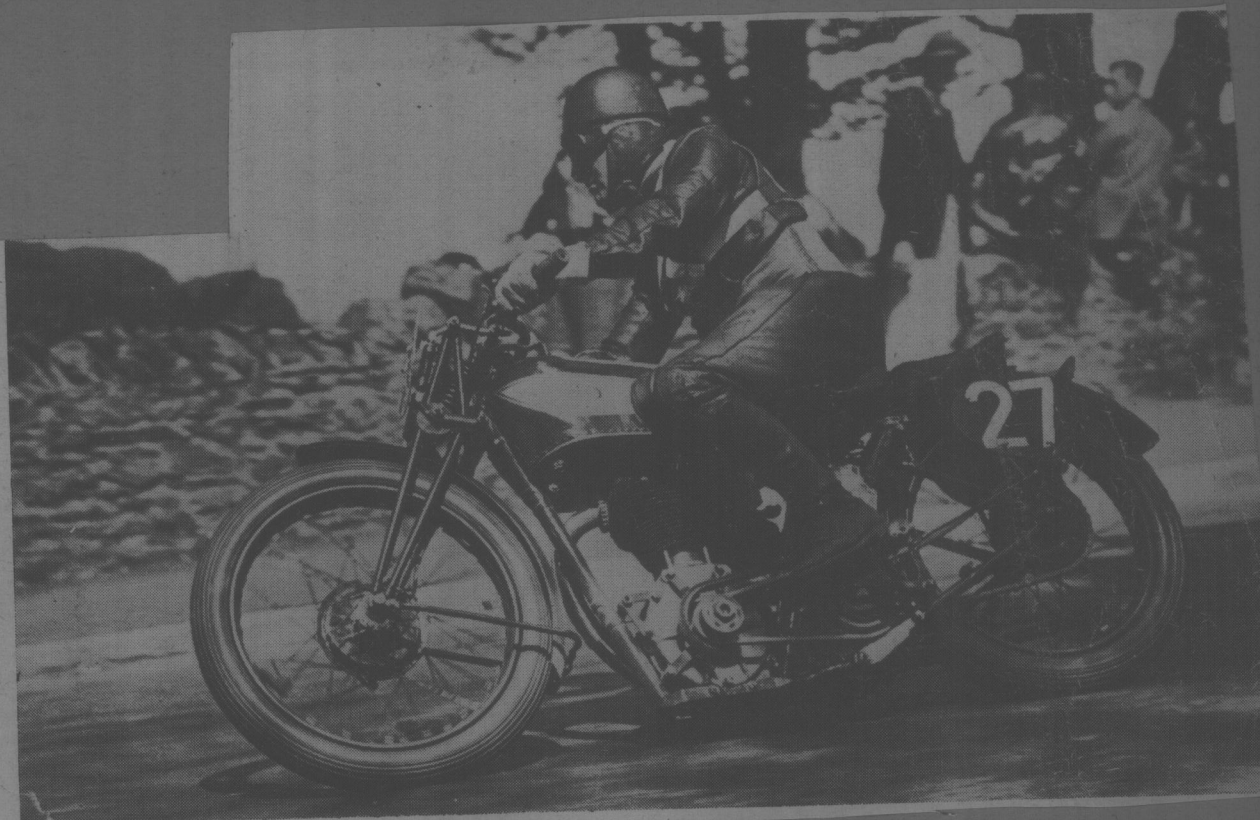


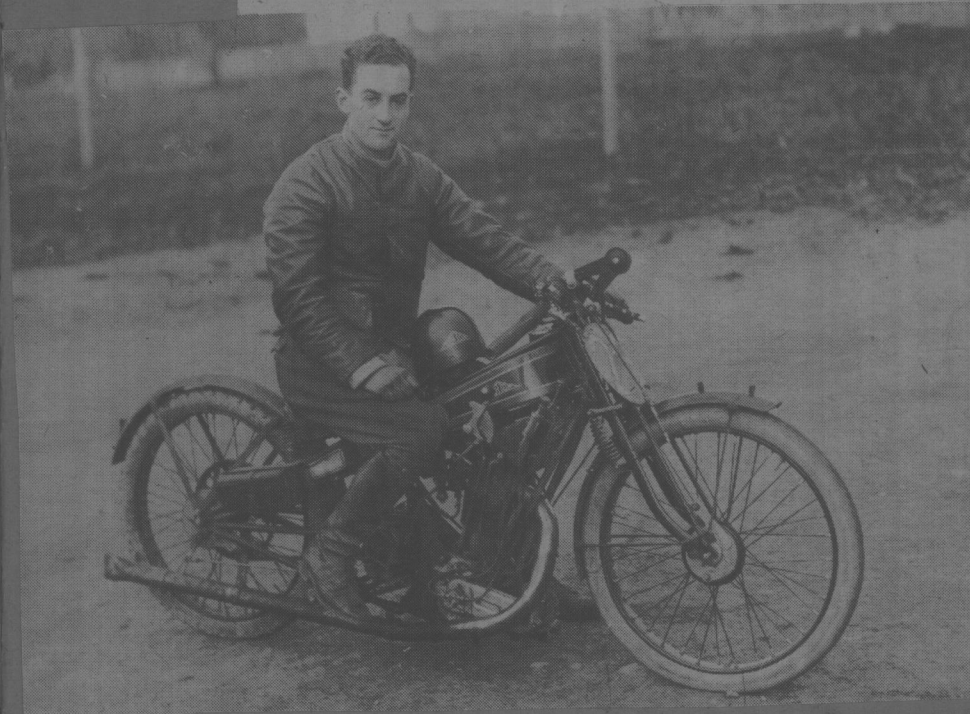


Right: Stanley Woods and Norton winning the 1932 Senior. Below: A sketch by Sallon for Shell-Mex and BP

Henry was well pleased

HENRY Rosenthal was well pleased with his first outing on his new Ossa on Sunday.

He took the bike—fitted like all Mick Andrews replicas, with his own Renthal alloy handlebars—to the Winsford Club's 112-rider Benoit Shield Trial in Cheshire and scored a seven mark victory over Brian Calkin (250 Bultaco).

Up to four sections from the end of the two lap event around Oulton Park, Henry had lost only five marks. But then, he said, "I went to my brother's section at Chester Lane and dropped it, then made a mess of my father's sections. It was most embarrassing."

Rosenthal's Manchester 17 teammates Dave Rowland and Ray Armstrong (500 BSA) were the best of the five sidecars taking their first three-wheeler win.
