SO to T road (Stanley Arms) where R , keep L and SO for 1 mile then L at fork, along lane to Farm, L through gate, along lane through splash, bear R through gate, to :- Youlswear Dam (observed) SO to main rd., where L . SO for 2½ miles then R , fork R down :- Cheeks Hill (observed 1 section) At bottom R to :-
12-27	1-42	9	OPEN CHECK , SO along main road for 1 mile to the Travellers Rest where L , take the 3rd turning on the L . L at fork to :- Washgates Splash (observed) and up hill to :- Washgates Hill (observed 2 sections) Carry on to T road where L and SO to main rd., where R , At Y rd., bear L (S P Buxton) take 2nd turning on the L (look out for stone monument at hairpin), SO up Roman Road to : Mount Pleasant (observed 1 section) SO , down hill, and at bottom R , through Goyts Valley , at T road L and SO to Pyms Elbow (observed) back to road, at Chaple R down hill to : Jenkins Chaple Hill (observed 2 sections) SO to BLUE BOAR FARM to :-
1-15	2-30	25	CHECK. <u>Repeat for 2nd LAP.</u> The milage is considered correct for the purpose of this Trial. As some of this course is on Private property we earnestly appeal to all competitors to close all gates. thank you. Abbreviations—S.O. straight on. L. left. S.P. signpost. R. right. Certain sections of the COURSE may be taped.
