

Eric Adcock's title

Eric Adcock, of Manchester, riding in the annual northern expert's trial yesterday organised by Chester Motor Club, improved on his title of Cheshire centre champion by putting up the best performance to become the northern territorial champion. Although he lost 24 marks on his 250 Dot, he was competing against 40 expert trials riders over a hazardous 15-mile course which started from Gwersylt.
